ABDOMINAL SONOGRAPHY, REVEALED :-

- **The liver** is mildly enlarged in size (16 cm in span at right MCL), displaying bright homogenous echogenicity, with no focal lesions detected.
- No intra or extra hepatic biliary radicles dilatation.
- **The gall bladder** is of normal capacity, normal wall thickness, with no stones or mud inside.
- Normal caliber of the **portal vein** (11mm) and **C.B.D.** (2.8 mm).
- Normal sonographic appearance of the **pancreas**.
- **The spleen** is of normal size (13 cm in its long axis), with homogenous echogenicity. No focal lesions.
- **Both kidneys** are normal in site, size, shape, parenchymal thickness and echogenicity with no renal stones or back pressure obstructive changes.
- Colonic gaseous distension is noted.
- No **ascites**.
